One Family's Legacy of Love



Fifteen years ago, the Russo family's lives were changed forever. Louis Russo Jr, beloved father and husband, was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease. It was in the last few years of Louis's life, with his illness progressing, that the family came to know Samaritan. They brought Samaritan into their home to provide medical care for Louis and to assist Joanne Russo, his wife and primary caregiver. Joanne was amazed by how quickly Samaritan organized the medical equipment Louis needed to be comfortable at home and a team to come in to help. Reflecting on Samaritan's care, Joanne emphasized, "It was the most loving thing I could do for my husband and even for myself."

Caring For Patient and Caregiver

Although Louis's dementia, a symptom of his disease, was advancing, he still recognized his team and greeted them with a "big smile on his face." Samaritan coordinates care plans around what each patient and caregiver needs, and Louis's Samaritan care team included - among other experts - massage therapists, music therapists, and aides.

Joanne felt joyful seeing her husband well cared for and smiling. She remarked, "Samaritan came into my home in a loving, caring, and professional way. 
Colleen Lason: Certified Home Health Aide / Preceptor & Care Coach
